- ✓ Signed and dated within last six months.
- ✓ Letter confirms Applicant is enrolled in a full-time program and will continue to be enrolled upon return.

#### 3. Letter of intent from Applicant

- ✓ Maximum one page, written in English.
- ✓ Signed and dated.
- ✓ Letter must describe: the nature of the studies to be undertaken; the rationale for choosing Canada, the University of Victoria, and the program; and, how the program will relate to the Applicant's future career.

#### 4. Letter of support from home university

- ✓ Prepared by Applicant's instructor, professor, or international director at home university.
- ✓ Maximum one page, written in English on official letterhead from home university.
- ✓ Signed and dated.
- ✓ Letter must explain the nature of the studies to be undertaken and how the Applicant and the home university will benefit from the scholarship program.

#### 5. Letter of invitation from the UVic supervisor

- ✓ Prepared by Applicant's Canadian supervisor.
- ✓ Maximum one page, in English or French, written on official UVic letterhead.
- ✓ Signed and dated.
- ✓ Letter must indicate the supervisor's willingness to support and mentor the candidate. It should also demonstrate how the Canadian institution, supervisor and peers will benefit.

# 5. Signed copy of Memorandum of Understanding or Agreement with Partner Institution (not mandatory for graduate applications)

- ✓ A written agreement or understanding, in English or in French, signed by both institutions indicating that tuition fees will not be charged and containing any other clauses of mutual interest.
- Note: a signed and valid copy of this document is mandatory for undergraduate and college applications.
  For graduate applications, if the exchange is made under a signed agreement, it is strongly suggested that it be included with the application.

6. Privacy notice statement (download from scholarship program website)

## ELIGIBILITY CHECKLIST

By submitting a scholarship application, the Applicant confirms he/she meets eligibility requirements published on the program website <u>www.scholarships.gc.ca</u> including the following:

- ✓ Applicant is not currently participating in an exchange program in Canada, or enrolled in a degree or diploma program at a Canadian university or college.
- ✓ Applicant does not hold any other major scholarships granted by the Government of Canada.
- ✓ If the scholarship application is successful, Applicant agrees to engage in full time studies/research for the duration of the program and abide by the terms and conditions of the scholarship program.
- ✓ If the scholarship application is successful, Applicant will arrive at UVic no earlier than August 1, 2024 and no later than February 1, 2025.
